

Supplementation in cancer patients receiving chemo or chemo/radiation therapy: A multicentric, randomized phase II study.

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Rationale: The use of supplements in cancer patients is justified by the low food intake caused by several factors. However, supplementation could be affected by adverse events (AE) related to oncologic treatment and vice-versa. The aim of this study was to compare the safety and efficacy of supplementation with serum milk isolated protein, leucin and zinc (IMMAX®) during treatment of these patients.

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
